In the context of the 12th Ministerial Conference of the World Trade Organisation (WTO) in Geneva, small-scale food producers organised under La Via Campesina, European Coordination Via Campesina and numerous national organisations are mobilising in Geneva to denounce the impact of free trade agreements (FTAs) and how they relate to the global food crisis.

As peasants, rural workers and small-scale farmers and founders of the concept of food sovereignty, we invite members of the press to attend various moments of the mobilisation. Get a first hand look into the global commitments of the food sovereignty movement and its fair trade systems and better understand how the WTO and FTAs are inflicting poverty, hunger, instability and crises around the globe.
